Sentry Board Meeting Packets...To keep costs down, Sentry will not be printing packets for these meetings. You can print your own copies by logging in to your Sentry account. Login to your account...go to Information Center...go to Community Information...go to Financials.

CC&Rs and Violations...Sentry will continue to monitor our neighborhood and call out violations. Our CC&Rs are in place to ensure and protect our property values. We all were made aware and agreed to these CC&Rs when we purchased our homes. Enforcement validates our agreement.



Pool Floaties...Please be aware of the size of your floaties. Big floaties can make it difficult to see small children. It's fine to bring them, just know that other people are in the pool also. Let's keep our pool safe.

Architectural Review Committee (ARC)

Please keep in mind that improvements that change the exterior of the property require approval from the ARC.

The process is as Easy as ABC!

Ask the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) if your intended change or construction is within guidelines by submitting a request.

- 1. Notify your neighbor of any projects that might cause them an inconvenience or affect their property.
 - 2. Complete the ARC form found at our Sentry Mgmt portal www.sentrymgt.com

 3. Add pictures and diagrams to completely describe the project.
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 - 4. Submit the form online. A response should arrive shortly. *The following projects do NOT need an ARC approval:*
- Mulching landscaping, general maintenance of landscape like trimming shrubs and bushes, planting annuals and perennials.
 - Exterior home maintenance and repairs that **do not** change the exterior of the home.

Be approved. Do not start your project until ARC approval is received.

- 1. The ARC may have questions about your project.
- 2. The ARC may need up to 30 days after receiving your request to provide a decision.
- 3. You will receive an email notification when the project is approved.
- 4. Any changes required by the ARC will be noted.

Complete your project (within 9 months) and notify the ARC when the project is finished.

- 1. Send an email to Sentry when the project is complete.
- 2. The ARC will inspect the project and document when the project is completed.


